

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 10th day of January

in the year of our Lord 1827 Between John F. Effinger

one of the Overseer of the Poor of the 1st District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Thomas Logan Jr of

the other part witnesseth, that the said Overeer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the 9th day of May

in the year 1828 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Richard Baker of the age of 18 years the

to be an Apprentice with him the said Thomas Logan Jr and as an Apprentice with him the said Thomas Logan Jr to dwell from the

the said 9th day of May 1828 until the said Richard Baker shall arrive, and come to the age of twenty one years according to the Act of the General

Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said Richard Baker shall the said Richard Baker

Thomas Logan Jr well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Richard Baker shall be put unto by his said Mother

according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said Richard Baker and the said Richard Baker honestly and obediently in all things be-

have towards the said Thomas Logan and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said Thomas Logan And the

said Thomas Logan Jr for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the

Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of Potter which

he the said Thomas Logan Jr now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and

informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Thomas Logan Jr shall also find and allow unto the said

Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

Thomas Logan Jr shall teach, or cause to be taught to the Richard Baker Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the

Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Richard Baker the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
