To The Sheriff, a Constable of said County.

Whereas, D. E. Croushore of the said County has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, T. A. Willis a Justice of the said County that

Joseph Turner of the said County on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 1916, in the said County, did unlawfully furnish intoxicating liquors to one Walter McCary a minor.

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said

Joseph Turner to answer the said complaint and to be further dealt with according to law. And you are required to summon Walter McCary + Charles Jenkins

to appear and give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth, on the examination touching the said offence.
