

This Indenture

MADE THE

day of August

in the year of our Lord 1842 Between Noah Beery

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the _____ District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and

George Moore of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the *15th* day of *August* in the year 1842 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *James Gentry* of the age of *11 years* the *7th* of *June* last years to be an Apprentice with him the said *George Moore* and as an Apprentice

with him the said *George Moore* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said

James Gentry shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

James Gentry shall the said *George Moore* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *George Moore* shall be put unto

by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *James Gentry* and

the said *James Gentry* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *George Moore*

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *George Moore*

And the said *George Moore* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby

promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *carpenter and joiner* which he the said

Geo. Moore now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

Geo. Moore shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel,

washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

George Moore shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *James Gentry*

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *James Gentry*

the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
