

This Indenture made this ~~the~~ seventeenth day of  
December one Thousand eight hundred and Five  
between Thomas Hopkins overseer of the poor for the south  
district in the County of Rockingham of the one part  
and Samuel Miller of said County of the other part  
witnesseth that the said overseer of the poor in pursuance  
of an Order of the Court of said County bearing date at  
November Court last doth put place and bind <sup>by</sup> Ezekiel  
Miller of said County a poor boy being Fourteen years  
of age the Twelfth day of Aprile last unto the said Samuel  
Miller to dwell with and serve him untill he shall arrive  
to the age of Twenty one years

In Consideration whereof the said ~~own~~ Samuel Miller  
doth bind himself to the said Thomas Hopkins or his  
successor overseer of the poor to teach said boy or cause  
him to be taught the Copper trade perfectly within  
Term above mentioned and to Furnish said boy with  
cloaths meet <sup>and</sup> drink, Lodging convenient for him and  
to teach or cause him to be taught to read and ~~write~~  
wright and common Arithmetic including the Rule  
of Three shall give unto said boy all such freedom  
dues as the Law directs In witness whereof each  
of us have set our hands and seals the day and  
Year above written
