

This Indenture made this 11th day of June
1840 between Jacob Trumbo one of the Overseers of the
Poor of the second District in County of Rockingham
of the one part and Richard Winfield of the other
part. Witnesseth that the said overseer of the poor
by virtue of an order of the County Court of the County
before said bearing date Oct. 1839. have just. placed and
bound Jefferson a free Boy of Colour of the age one year
and 8 months old the 15 of October 1839 to be an apprentice
with him the S^r Richard Winfield and as an ap-
prentice with him the S^r Richard Winfield to dwell
from the date of these presents until the S^r Jefferson arrive
and come to the age of Twenty One years. According to the
Act of Assembly made and provided. For and during all
which time and term that S^r Jefferson shall the said
Richard Winfield well and faithfully serve in all
such Lawfull business as the S^r Jefferson shall be
put ^{into} by the Richard Winfield according to the power
wit^h and ability of him the said Jefferson and the
S^r Jefferson shall honestly and obediently in all things
behave towards the said Richard Winfield and honestly
and Orderly towards the family of S^r Richard Winfield
and that the S^r Richard Winfield for himself
Executors and Administrators doth hereby Covenant
and promise to and with the S^r Overseers of the Poor
and his Successors in office for the time being that
the S^r Apprentice shall the Craft. Mystery or Occupation
of a Farmer which in the Richard Winfield now
useth after the best manner that he can or may
teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught
instructed and informed as much as therein to belong
th or in anywise appertaineth and that the S^r
Richard Winfield shall allow the said apprentice
Sufficient meat drink, apparel washing lodging and
all other things needfull or meet for an apprentice
during the term of said term and at the expiration of the

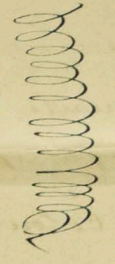
