And that the said Pa nee Showattery shall also find and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an apprentice, during the term aforesaid. And also that the said Dance Showattery shall teach, or cause to be taught, to the said batharin Gator reading, writing and common arithmetic including the rule of three, and will, moreover, pay the said Catharine Golan the sum of , Yerenty Dollars at the expiration of the aforesaid term.
