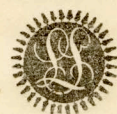


THIS INDENTURE, made the 10 day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty Six between George Branner Overseers of the Poor for ~~the~~ district of the county of Rockingham of the one part, and Daniel Showatters of said county, of the other part, witnesseth, that the said George Branner Overseers of the Poor as aforesaid, by virtue of an order of the Court of the aforesaid county, bearing date the September Court 1846 have put, placed and bound, and by these presents do put, place and bind Catharan Eaton of the age of one year old on 1st Jan'y 1846 years, to be an apprentice with him the said Daniel Showatters and as an apprentice with him the said Daniel Showatters to dwell, from the date of these presents until the said Catharan Eaton shall attain the age of Eighteen years, according to the act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. By and during which time and term, the said Catharan Eaton shall the said Daniel Showatters her said master, well and faithfully serve, in all such lawful business as the said Catharan Eaton shall be put unto by her said master, according to the power, wit and ability of her the said Catharan Eaton and honestly and obediently in all things shall behave herself towards her said master, and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the family of the said Daniel Showatters And the said Daniel Showatters for his part, for himself, his executors and administrators, doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseers of the Poor, and every of them, their and every of their executors and administrators, and their and every of their successors for the time being, and to and with the said Catharan Eaton that he the said Daniel Showatters shall instruct the said Catharin Eaton in the craft, mystery and occupation of a house keeping which he the said Daniel Showatters now uses, after the best manner that he can or may, teach, instruct and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth. And that the said Daniel Showatters shall also find and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an apprentice, during the term aforesaid. And also that the said Daniel Showatters shall teach, or cause to be taught, to the said Catharin Eaton reading, writing and common arithmetic including the rule of three, and will, moreover, pay the said Catharin Eaton the sum of Twenty Dollars at the expiration of the aforesaid term. In witness whereof, the parties have interchangeably set their hands and seals to these presents the day and year first above written.
