

# THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE

4<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord 1836 Between John Nigar

one of the Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Isaac Hardesty of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the day of September in the year 1836 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Nancy Hogan of the age of 10 years in Jan<sup>y</sup> next ~~to~~ to be an Apprentice with him the said Isaac Hardesty and as an Apprentice with him the said Isaac Hardesty to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Nancy Hogan shall arrive, and come to the age of eighteen years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said Nancy Hogan shall the said Isaac Hardesty well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Nancy Hogan shall be put unto by ~~the~~ said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said Nancy Hogans and the said Nancy Hogans honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said Isaac Hardesty And the said Isaac Hardesty for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of ~~Scemotrefs~~ which he the said ~~now useth~~, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Isaac Hardesty shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the ~~the~~ term aforesaid: And also that the said Isaac Hardesty shall teach, or cause to be taught to the Nancy Hogan Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three and will moreover pay to the said Nancy Hogan the Sum of twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
