

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE *Twelfth* day of *July* . . . . .

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid  
bearing date the day of *July* . . . . . in the year 18*26* . . . . .  
has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Jacob Fletcher* of the age  
of *about Eleven* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *James O'Brien*  
and as an Apprentice with him the said *James O'Brien* to dwell from the date of these presents,  
until the said *Jacob Fletcher* shall arrive and come to the age of *Twenty one*  
years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. by and during all which time and term the said  
*Jacob Fletcher* shall the said *James O'Brien* his said  
*Master* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Jacob*  
shall be put unto by *his said Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *him*  
the said *Jacob* *shall* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards *James*  
*O'Brien* *his said Master* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family  
of the said *James O'Brien* And the said *James O'Brien*  
for himself, *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his  
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Boot & Shoe maker*  
which he the said *James O'Brien* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,  
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that  
he the said *James O'Brien* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient  
meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that  
the said *James O'Brien* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Jacob Fletcher*  
Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Jacob*  
*Fletcher* the Sum of *Fifteen Dollars* Dollars at the Expiration of the
