

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 26th day of March
in the year of our Lord 1827 Between Henry Kisting Conrad Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Henry Kisting
of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
bearing date the fourth day of January in the year 1827
has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Elijah Berry of the age
of 8 years the 25th Sept 1826 years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Henry Kisting
and as an Apprentice with him the said Henry Kisting to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said Elijah Berry shall arrive and come to the age of Twenty one
years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

Elijah Berry shall the said Henry Kisting his said
Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Elijah Berry
shall be put unto by his said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of
the said Elijah Berry and honestly and obediently in all things behave towards
his said Master and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family
of the said Henry Kisting And the said Henry Kisting

for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Cooper
which he the said Henry Kisting now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said Henry Kisting shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient
meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said Henry Kisting shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Elijah Berry
Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Elijah Berry
the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the
aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
above written.
