

 This Indenture ~~and~~ witnesseth that I John Lincoln Overseer of the Poor for the Parish and County of Rockingham, by an Order of Court, (held June 1795, for said County) to me directed, hath & by these Presents doth, put & bind Sarah, ^{Grace} Daughter of James Grace of the Age of five years the first Day of June last past, Apprentice to Peter Setty Jr. of the same Parish to serve him ~~until she arrives~~ in the said Parish, until she arrives at the Age of eighteen Years; during which Term, the said Apprentice her said Master faithfully shall serve, his Secrets keep, his lawful Commands every where obey; she shall do no damage to her said Master, nor willfully suffer it to be done by others; she shall ^{neither} buy nor sell without her said Masters leave, Fornication shall not commit, Matrimony, shall not contract, at Cards, Dice, or any other unlawful Game she shall not play; with her own Goods, or the Goods of others whereby her said Master may have Damage, nor haunt Alehouses, Taverns or Play-houses, she shall not waste her said Masters Goods nor lend ^{them} to any without his consent, but in all Things behave herself as a good & faithful Servant or Apprentice ought to do.

In Consideration whereof, the said Master shall provide and procure sufficient Meat, Drink, Washing, Lodging, and Apparel fitting for such Apprentice, during the said Term, and teach the said Apprentice to read the Bible well, & write a tolerable Hand, and learn her, or cause her to be learned to knit, sew, & Spin, and at the Expiration of said Term, pay, or cause to be paid to said Apprentice, the Freedom Due customary & lawful for such Apprentice. In Witness whereof each Parties bind themselves to the other firmly by these Presents. Sealed with their Seals this fifteenth Day of December, one Thousand seven Hundred & Ninety five.
