In Confideration whereof, the faid Mafter shall provide and procure sufficient Meat, Drink, Mashing, Lodging, and Apparel strong for Speck Apparentice, during the said Jerry, and teach the said Apparentice to read the Buble well, & write a Tolerable Han, and learn her, or canse her to be learn I to knit, few, & Ipin, and at the Capmathon of faid Term, payor earle to be paid to faid the prentice, the Freedom Dnew customary & lawful for puch Apparentice. In Witness whereof each Partie bind therespelved to the other formly by these Presents. Sealed with their Seale this sifteenth Day of December, some Thousand seven Thurdred & Nintely five.
