

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 19 day of September

in the year of our Lord 1820 Between Aaron Solomon Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Leonard Mowry

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid

baring date the day of September in the year 1820

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Barbara Ann Sicely of the age

of Nine in February last years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Leonard Mowry

and as an Apprentice with him the said Leonard Mowry to dwell from the date of these presents,

until the said Barbara Ann shall arrive and come to the age of Eighteen

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

Barbara Ann Sicely shall the said Leonard Mowry his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Leonard Mowry

shall be put unto by him according to the Power, Wit and Ability of her the said Barbara Ann

the said Barbara Ann shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him

the said Leonard Mowry and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said Leonard Mowry And the said Leonard Mowry

for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a housewife Spinning &c

which he the said now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said Leonard Mowry shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that

the said Leonard Mowry shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Barbara Ann Sicely

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Barbara Ann

Sicely the Sum of fifteen Dollars Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year

above written.
