

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE fourth day of January

in the year of our Lord 1821 Between Aaron Solomon Overseer of the Poor of the South East District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Jacob Kiblinger

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the day of December in the year of 1820

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Nanny Plumb* a Mulattoe of the age

*of nine years old the first day of March last* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Jacob Kiblinger* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Jacob Kiblinger* to dwell ~~from the date of these presents,~~

until the said *Nanny Plumb* shall arrive and come to the age of *eighteen* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

*Nanny Plumb* shall the said *Jacob Kiblinger* her ~~his~~ said Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Jacob Kiblinger* *Nanny Plumb*

shall be put unto by *the said Jacob Kiblinger* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *the said Nanny Plumb* ~~the said Jacob Kiblinger~~ and honestly and obediently in all things behave towards

~~the said Jacob Kiblinger~~ the said *Jacob Kiblinger* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of the said *Jacob Kiblinger*

And the said *Jacob Kiblinger* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *Housewifery that is Spinning* ~~which he the said~~ *Sewing and Knitting*

~~now teach,~~ after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said *Jacob Kiblinger* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: ~~And also that~~

~~the said~~ ~~shall teach or cause to be taught to the said~~ ~~Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three,~~ and will moreover pay to the said

*Nanny Plumb* the Sum of *fifteen* Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year

above written.
