

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 3th day of July

in the year of our Lord 1822 Between Samuel Bowman an Overseer of the Poor of the
Northem District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and John Kline

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
barring date the June ~~day of~~ court in the year 1822

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Samuel Hoover a poor boy of the age
of Eight ~~years old~~ ^{now} ~~21 may last~~, to be an Apprentice with him the said John Kline

and as an Apprentice with him the said John Kline to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said Samuel Hoover shall arrive and come to the age of Twenty one

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said
Samuel Hoover shall the said John Kline his said

Mother well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Samuel Hoover
shall be put unto by the said John Kline according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him

the said Samuel Hoover and shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him
the said John Kline and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said John Kline And the said John Kline
for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Farmer
which he the said John Kline now useth, ^{or followeth} after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said John Kline shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient


meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said John Kline shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Samuel Hoover


Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Samuel
Hoover the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the
