

This Indenture made this 10th day of February one
Thousand eight Hundred and five between Thomas Hopkins
Overseer of the poor for the South District in the County of
Rockingham of the one part and Alex^r. Graham of said
County of the other part witnesseth that the said overseer
of the poor in pursuance of an order of Court bearing
date at September Court last doe put place and bind
Cheston Dunavan a poor boy of said County being
ten years old the 23 day of June last past as an
apprentice unto ^{the said} Alex^r. Graham to dwell with and
serve him untill he shall arrive to the age of
Twenty one years -

In Consideration where of the said Alex^r. Graham or
doth bind him self his to the said Tho^s. Hopkins or his
Successor overseer of the poor to teach or instruct or cause to
be taught the said Cheston Dunavan the art and mystery
of a Saddler within the time above mentioned and to furnish
the said apprentice with meat drink and lodging full and
convenient for such apprentice and to teach or cause ^{him} to
be taught to read and write and Common Arithmatick
including the Rule of three and at the end of his apprenticeship
shall give unto said apprentice all such freedom dues
as the law directs in witness whereof each of us hoith
here unto sett our hands and seals the day and year
above written -
