

This indenture made the 17th day of December on the year 1816 between Aaron Solomon and Richard P Fletcher overseer of the poor in the county of Rockingham of the one part and Henry Pultz of the same county of the other part witnesseth that the said overseer of the poor in pursuance of an order of the county court of Rockingham made at June court 1816 do put and bind Christian (a free boy of colour) five years old the 3rd day of April 1816 also George (a free boy of colour) three years old the 1st day of February last as apprentices to him the said Henry Pultz and with him after the manner of apprentices to dwell and serve until each of them shall arrive to the age of twenty one years. In consideration of which the said Henry Pultz binds himself to the said Solomon and R Fletcher or his successors in office to find the said apprentices in good and sufficient clothes meat drink and lodging fit and convenient for such apprentices and also at the end of their said apprenticeship shall pay or cause to be paid to each of said apprentices the sum of twenty dollars.
