

This Indenture MADE THE *Twentyfifth* day of *July*

in the year of our Lord 1840 Between *Jacob Rohr Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and *Samuel Coffman* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date ~~the~~ *July* day of ~~June~~ *June* in the year 1840 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Mariett Clatterbaugh* of the age of *Fourteen* years to be an Apprentica with him the said *Samuel Coffman* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Samuel Coffman* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Eighteen* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* shall the said *Samuel Coffman* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* shall be put unto by ~~the~~ *her* said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* and the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Samuel Coffman* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Samuel Coffman* And the said *Samuel Coffman* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of _____ which he the said _____ now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth; and that the said *Samuel Coffman* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Samuel Coffman* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Mariett Clatterbaugh* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
