

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 10<sup>th</sup> day of March

in the year of our Lord 1825 Between Robert Miller Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Joseph Wenger

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid  
barring date the day of December Court in the year 1824

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Augustus Underwood of the age  
of Eleven years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Joseph Wenger

and as an Apprentice with him the said Joseph Wenger to dwell from the date of these presents,  
until the said Augustus Underwood shall arrive and come to the age of twenty one

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said  
~~Augustus Underwood~~ shall the said Joseph Wenger his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Augustus Underwood  
shall be put unto by s<sup>r</sup> Joseph Wenger according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him the s<sup>d</sup> Underwood &  
the said Joseph Wenger honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him the  
said Joseph Wenger and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said Joseph Wenger And the said Joseph Wenger  
for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his  
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Farmer

which he the said Joseph Wenger now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,  
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that  
he the said Joseph Wenger shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that  
the said Joseph Wenger shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Augustus Underwood

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Augustus  
Underwood the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year  
above written.
