

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE *The fifth* day of *January*
in the year of our Lord 18 *29* Between *Ruben Moore* ———— Overseer of the Poor of the
of the So Est District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Benjamin Miller*
of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
bearing date the *fifth* day of *January* in the year *Eighteen Hundred & Twenty Nine*
has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Larken Williams* ———— of the age
of *fifteen years & six months*, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Benjamin Miller* ————
and as an Apprentice with him the said *Benjamin Miller* ———— to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said *Larken Williams* ———— shall arrive and come to the age of *Twenty one* ————
years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said
Larken Williams ———— shall the said *Benjamin Miller* ———— his said
Master ———— well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Larken Williams*,
shall be put unto by *Benjamin Miller* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *Larken Williams*
the said *Larken Williams* ———— honestly and obediently in all things behave towards *Benjamin*
Miller his ———— said *Master* ———— and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family
of the said *Benjamin Miller* And the said *Benjamin Miller* ————
for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Mill Right*
which he the said *Benjamin Miller* ———— now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said *Benjamin Miller* ———— shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient
meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said *Benjamin Miller* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Larken Williams*,
Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Larken*
Williams the Sum of *Twenty* ———— Dollars at the Expiration of the
aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
