



Know all men by these presents, that we John Brown
and Jacob Reesh are held and firmly bound unto the
President and Directors of the Literary Fund and their
successors in Office, in the just and full sum of \$4705.68,
to which payment well and truly to be made, to the said
President and Directors of the Literary Fund, and their successors
in Office, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administra-
tors, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with
our seal, and dated this 19th day of December, 1836.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the above
bound John Brown, was on the 17th day of October, 1836 by the School Com-
missioners in and for the County of Rockingham appointed their Treas-
urer for the year ending on the 31st day of December 1837. Now if the said
John Brown, shall faithfully apply and account for all monies which
may come to his hands by virtue of his Office, and shall do, perform and
execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his said Office,
according to Law, then the above obligation to be void, or else to re-
main in full force and virtue.
