THIS INDENTURE, made the 17 th day of ecene in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourth Sivenbetween george pruner Overseers of the Poor for the discreet of the county of Boeveinghan the one part, and focol pear of said county, of the other part, witnesseth, that the said George Brianna Overseers of the Poor as aforesaid, by virtue of an order of the Court of the aforesaid county, bearing date SpiC CoicorL 1847 have put, placed and bound, and by these presents do put, place and bind WiClearmeamof the age of fourteen years, to be an apprentice with him the said Gacol Beam e and as an apprentice with him the said qacob Beam - to dwell, from the date of these presents until the said Nileiarn Beam shall attain the age of 2/ years, according to the act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. By and during which time and term, the said Melian Beam shall the said Gacol Beam - his said master, well and faithfully serve, in all such lawful business as the said Cilia Beam shall be put unto by his said master, according to the power, wit and ability of him the said lelileiam beam and honestly and obediently in all things shall behave himself towards his said master, and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the family of the said faecal dsearn_And the said Gacol beam - for his part, for himself, his executors and administrators, doth here. by promise and covenant to and with the said Overseers of the Poor, and every of them, their and every of their executors and administrators, and their and every of their successors for the time being, and to and with the said Williarn Bears that he the said gacob beam shall instruct the said ecilíain Beam in the craft, mystery and occupation of a Shoumater which he the said gaia Beam - now uses, after the best manner that he can or may, teach, instruct and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth. And that the said fatal Beam shall also find and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an apprentice, during the term aforesaid. And also that the said Gacole beam shall teach, or cause to be taught, to the said william beam reading, writing and common arithmetic including the rule of three, and will, moreover, pay the said William Beam the sum of Seventy Dollars at the expiration of the aforesaid term.
