One thousand Eight hundred and Eighteen Between
Philip Braner overseer of the poor for the North
District in the County of Rockingham of the one part
and John Shaver of the s^d County of the other
part Witnesseth that the s^d overseer of the poor in
Pursuance of an order of the Court of s^d County of
Rockingham bearing Date Last Court
Do put and Bind William Poole of the s^d County
fourteen years of Age the ~~fifteen~~ ^{fifteen} Day of May Next
As Apprentice to the s^d John Shaver With him after
the Manner of an Apprentice to dwell and serve
untill he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years
to Learn the art and Mistry of Shoemaking

In Consideration of Which the s^d John Shaver Binds
Himself to the Philip Braner or his Successor overseer
of the Poor to teach and Instruct or Cause to be
taught and Instructed the s^d William Poole the art
and Mistry aforesaid During s^d term and moreover
to find the s^d Poole in Good and sufficient Cloathes
Meat Drink Washing and Lodging fit and Convenient
for such Apprentice and teach him to Read Write and
Common Arithmetick Including the Rule of three and
also at the End of his service shall pay and satisfy
to the s^d Poole all such freedom dues as he shall
have a right to demand In Witness Where of
