

This Indenture MADE THE 16th day of June

in the year of our Lord 1845 Between Peter Hinton

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and

John Weaver of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the June Court in the year 1845 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Mary. Quivers of the age of six years the old Mary 1845 to be an Apprentice with him the said John Weaver and as an Apprentice with him the said John Weaver to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said

shall arrive, and come to the age of Eighteen years, according

to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

Mary. Quivers shall the said John Weaver

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Mary. Quivers shall be put unto

by his said J. Weaver according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said M. Quivers and

the said M. Quivers honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said John

Weaver and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said John Weaver

And the said John Weaver for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby

promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of House Keeping &c. which he the said

John Weaver now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

John Weaver shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel,

washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

John Weaver shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said Mary. Quivers

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Mary. Quivers

the Sum of \$20 Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
