

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in
and for the body of the county of Rockingham, and now attending
said Court at its October term, 1930, upon their oaths present
that George Morris, within one year next prior to the finding
of this indictment, in said county, did unlawfully ^{have in his} ~~transport~~
^{possession} one pint of ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of
the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of J. L.
Dirting, H. R. Dinges, and G. A. Lawson, witnesses sworn in
Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.

Commonwealth of Virginia,
Rockingham County, To-Wit:

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 3 day of Sept, 1930,
George Morris, principal and Zack Raines
surety, who justified to his sufficiency, came before me, Shelby Davis
Bail Commissioner, of the said County of Rockingham,
(J. P. or Bail Commissioner)

and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia each in the sum of
Five Hundred Dollars, (\$ 500⁰⁰),
to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, for the use of the Common-
wealth of Virginia rendered, and they each severally waived their homestead exemption to their re-
cognizance; yet upon this condition:

That if the said George Morris shall personally appear before
the Circuit Court of Rockingham County, at the Courthouse of said County, on the 1st day of the
October, 1930, Term thereof, being the 20 day of October,
1930, and at such other time or times to which the proceedings may be continued or further
heard, and before any court or judge hereafter having or holding any proceedings in connection with
the said charge, and then and there answer the Commonwealth of Virginia concerning a certain
misdemeanor whereof the said George Morris stands
charged, and be bound under said recognizance until the charge is finally disposed of or until it is
declared void by order of a competent court, then the above recognizance shall be null and void; other-
wise to remain in full force and effect.
