
Sarah Flowers
Indenture


This Indenture made the 5th day of August 1817
Between Jacob Miller overseer of the Poor in the
County of Rockingham of the one part, and Mary
Snider of the County aforesaid of the other part,
Witnesseth: That the said Jacob Miller Overseer of
the Poor as aforesaid hath, In conformity to an Order
of the Court of the aforesaid County, put place & Bound,
and by these presents do put place and Bind Sarah
Flowers a poor child whose parents are not able to
support her as an Apprentice to her the S^d Mary
Snider and as an Apprentice to dwell with her
from the date of these presents untill she attain
the age of Eighteen years which will be on the
24th day of October one thousand eight hundred and
Twenty two during all which time the said Sarah
Flowers shall her S^d Mistress well and truly serve
in all such Lawfull Business as she shall be
put unto by her S^d Mistress according to the
power, wit and ability of her the S^d Sarah
Flowers, and shall honestly and Obediently behave
herself toward her said Mistress, and also honestly
and Obediently behave herself toward the Family
of her said Mistress. And the said Mary
Snider on her part shall Teach and Instruct,
or cause to be Taught and Instructed her S^d


Apprentice Reading the Testament and Bible well,
and to knit, ~~and~~ spin and sew, and the said
Mary Snyder shall also find and allow unto her
said Apprentice sufficient Meat, Drink,
Washing, Lodging and Apparel, and all other
things usefull or Necessary for and Apprentice
during the time aforesaid. And Moreover pay
unto the said Apprentice at the expiration of
her time the sum of ~~Eighteen~~ ^{Fifteen} Dollars.




