

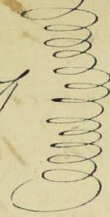
This Indenture made this 13th day of June 1840
between Jacob Saumbo One of the Overseers of the
Poor of the second district in the County of Rich-
ingham of the one part and Richard Winfield
of the other part (Witnesseth, that the said Overseer
of the Poor by authority of an order of the County Court
of the County aforesaid bearing date October
1839 have put place and found, and by these
presents doth put place and bind Mary a free
girl of Colours 3 years old the 18th October 1839 to
be an apprentice with him the said Richard
Winfield, and as an apprentice with him the
said Richard Winfield to dwell with him from
the date of these presents until the said Mary shall
arrive and come to the age of twenty one years
according to the Act of Assembly in that Case made
and provided: For and during all which time and
term that the said Mary shall the said Richard Winfield
well and faithfully serve in all such lawful
business as the said Mary shall be put unto by
his said Master according to the power and
ability of her the said Mary and the said Mary
honestly and obediently in all things behave to-
wards the said Richard Winfield and honestly
and ~~obediently~~ towards the family of him the said Richard
Winfield and the said Richard Winfield for himself
his Executors and Administrators doth hereby covenant and
promise to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his suc-
cessors in Office, for the time being that the said apprentice
shall the Craft, Mystery or Occupation of a Housekeeper
which the said Richard Winfield now useth after the
best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform
or cause to be taught, instructed and informed as much
as thoreunto belongeth or in any wise appertaining
and that the said Richard Winfield shall allow
to the said apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel

give to the said Mary the sum of Twenty dollars
