

This Indenture MADE THE 25th day of July

in the year of our Lord 1841 Between Jacob Roke Sr.

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and *Mary Ryle* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the *July* ~~day of~~ *Court* in the year 1841 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Melina Colly* of the age of *seven* years to be an Apprentice with *her* the said *Mary Ryle* and as an Apprentice with *her* the said *Mary Ryle* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Melina Colly* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Eighteen* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Melina Colly* shall the said *Mary Ryle* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Melina Colly* shall be put unto by *her* said *Mistress* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Melina Colly* and the said *Melina Colly* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Mary Ryle* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of *her* the said *Mary Ryle*

And the said *or himself* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *which he the said* ~~now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform~~ ~~or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said~~ *Mary Ryle* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: ~~And also that the said~~ ~~shall teach, or cause to be taught to~~

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of *Three*, and will moreover pay to the said *Melina Colly* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
