of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid  
bearing date the *fourth* day of *April* - in the year *Eighteen hundred & twenty six*  
has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Samuel Brown* ----- of the age  
of *fourteen* ~~years~~ *years* to be an Apprentice with him the said *Jahue Laker* -----  
and as an Apprentice with him the said *Jahue Laker* ----- to dwell from the date of these presents,  
until the said *Samuel Brown* ----- shall arrive and come to the age of *twenty one* -----  
years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that  
he the said *Jahue Laker* ----- shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient  
meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that  
the said *Jahue Laker* ----- shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Samuel Brown*  
Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Samuel*  
*Brown* the Sum of *Twenty Dollars* Dollars at the Expiration of the
