And that The said Juckson Horn Shall also find and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat and drink apparel washing, Rodging, and all other things needful or meet for an apprentice during the term oforesaid and also that the Said Jackson Hon shall leach or cause to be taught to the Said Relieved Blakeley reading and writing and will mor - eover the said Reliecca Blakeley the sum of leventy Dolla as the fusion aus.
