

This indenture, made the 4th day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and forty four between Jacob Trumbo Overseer of the poor
for the District of the County of Rockingham, ^{and State of Va.} of the one
part and Jackson Horn of the said County of the other part
witnesseth that the said Jacob Trumbo Overseer of the poor as
aforesaid by virtue of an order of the Court of the aforesaid
County bearing date the 20th of April, 1844 have put
placed and bound, and by these presents do put, place and
bind Rebecca A Blakeley of the age of nine years old in June
1844 to be an apprentice with him the said Jackson Horn and
as an apprentice with him the said Jackson Horn to dwell
from the date of these presents until the said Rebecca A
Blakeley shall attain the age of eighteen years, according
to the act of the General Assembly in that case made and
provided, By and during all which time and term, the said
Rebecca Blakeley, shall the said Jackson Horn her said
master well and faithfully serve, in all such lawful
business as the said Rebecca Blakeley shall be put unto
by her said master, according to the power, wit and ability
of her the said Rebecca Blakeley and honestly and obedient-
ly in all things shall behave herself towards her said
master, and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the
family of the said Jackson Horn } And the said Jackson
Horn for his part, for himself, his executors and adminis-
trators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said
overseer of the poor, and every of them, their and every of their
executors and administrators and their and every of their successo-
rs for the time during, and to and with the said Rebecca Blak-
eley, that he the said Jackson Horn shall instruct or cause
to be instructed the said Rebecca Blakeley in all necessary
business spinning, sewing, knitting &c. and all that is necessary
to be taught to such apprentice, after the best manner that
he can or may teach, instruct and inform, or cause to be
taught instructed and informed as much as thereunto
belongeth or in anywise appertaineth

And that the said Jackson Horn shall also find and allow unto the said apprentice sufficient meat and drink apparel washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an apprentice during the term aforesaid and also that the said Jackson Horn shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Rebecca Blakeley reading and writing and will moreover ^{pay} the said Rebecca Blakeley the sum of twenty Dollars ^{as her freedom dues} at the expiration of the aforesaid term, in witness whereof the parties have interchangeably set their hands and seals to these presents the day and year first above mentioned.
