## In Re: Park Condemnation Proceedure.

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 7th, 1932, and in reply, beg to say, that it is our understanding, under the order of the Court referred to, that it is your duty to mail a copy of the newspaper publication referred to, to every person who has filed a claim or an answer in the record of the condemnation case in your office; that is to say prepare a list of the claims filed and the post office addresses of the claimants as given in the claim; of if claimant has subsequently to the filing of that claim filed with you a change of post office address, use the last address given. Then mail a copy of the newspaper publication to each of these claimants at the last post office address.

In your County, we understand that the Board or Appraisal Commissioners did not report on a number of tracts of land within the first area for the reason that we were requested not to do so by the State owing to the fact that the State was contemplating submitting a motion to dismiss proceedings as to such tracts unreported. However, we believe under the strict language of the order, it becomes your duty to send a notice to each person who has filed a claim, whether the Board has reported upon sich claim or not, for the reason that such claimant might wish to move the Court to compel the State to either dismiss proceedings as to his land, or require the Board to report on seme.

If we have not made ourselves clear, we should be very pleased to visit you and go over the matter with you.
