

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 16th day of June

in the year of our Lord 1834 Between John H.

Effinger one of the Overseer of the Poor of the Harrisonburg District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Christian Moyers of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the May 16th 1834 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind William Roadcap of the age of Three

and as an Apprentice with him the said Christian Moyers to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said William Roadcap shall arrive, and come to the age of Twenty-one years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during

all which time and term the said William Roadcap shall the said Christian Moyers well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said William Roadcap shall be put unto by his said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said William Roadcap and the said Roadcap honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said Christian Moyers

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said Moyers And the said Moyers for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation

of a Farmer which he the said Moyers now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Moyers shall also find

and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the the term aforesaid: And also that the said Moyers shall teach, or cause to be taught to the 1st Roadcap Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three

and will moreover pay to the said Roadcap the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
