Roadcap, against the form of the statute, received and accepted delivery of one quart of whiskey from the said Adams Express Company at its office at Dayton, Va., in the County aforesaid, having within a period of thirty days prior thereto, to-wit, on June 1, 1917, received and accepted delivery of a certain other quart of whiskey from the same carrier at the same place, both of the said deliveries being of whiskey consigned to the said C.M. Roadcap and transported by the Adams Express Company,
