



This Indenture made this the sixteenth Day of March in the
 Year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & Eight between
 John Kratzer one of the overseers of the Poor
 in the County of Rockingham of the one part
 and Ferdinand Cain of said County of the other part witnesseth
 that the said John Kratzer an overseer of the Poor as aforesaid
 by virtue of an order of Court of the aforesaid County
 bearing date the March fifteenth Day in the year 1808 have
 put placed & bound & by these Presents do put place & bind
 Rachel Blizgerd a poor girl whose parents are not able
 to maintain her of the age of nine ^{fourteen days} years to live &
 dwell with him the said Ferdinand Cain from the date of
 these Presents until the said Rachel Blizgerd shall come to the
 age of eighteen years according to the act of the General
 assembly in that behalf made & provided by & during
 all which time & term the said Rachel Blizgerd
 shall the said Ferdinand Cain her said master well &
 faithfully serve in all such lawfull business as the said
 Rachel Blizgerd shall be put on to by her said master
 according to the Power wit & ability of her the said
 Rachel Blizgerd & honestly & obediently in all
 things shall behave her self towards her said master
 and honestly & orderly towards the rest of the family
 of the said Ferdinand Cain & the said Ferdinand Cain
 for his part for him self his Executors & administrators
 both here by promise & Covenant to & with the said
 overseer of the poor & his heirs Executors & administrators
 & successors for the time being & to & with the said
 Rachel Blizgerd that he the said Ferdinand Cain
 shall the said Rachel Blizgerd in the Craft ~~my~~
 mystery & occupation of Sawing spinning nitting
 after the best manner that he the said Cain or may teach
 instruct & inform or cause to be taught instructed
 & informed as much as there to be taught or in any
 wise appertaineth & that the said Ferdinand Cain shall
 also find and allow unto the said Rachel Blizgerd
 sufficient meat drink apparel washing lodging & all
 other things needfull during the term aforesaid
 & also that the said Ferdinand Cain shall teach
 or cause to be taught to the said Rachel Blizgerd
 Reading & ^{writing} at the expiration of her aforesaid
 term give the sum of twelve dollars
