in the year of our Lord 1827 Between Henry Hisling Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Peter Boyer

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid

baring date the first day of January in the year 1827

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Susana Berry of the age

of 2 years the 23rd July last years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Peter Boyer

and as an Apprentice with him the said Peter Boyer to dwell from the date of these presents,

until the said Susana Berry shall arrive and come to the age of Eighteen

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

Susana Berry shall the said Peter Boyer his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Susana Berry

shall be put unto by P. Peter Boyer according to the Power, Wit and Ability of her the said Susana

her said Master and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Weaver

which he the said Peter Boyer now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said Peter Boyer shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that

the said Peter Boyer shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Susana Berry

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the ~~Single Rule of Three~~, and will moreover pay to the said Susana Berry

the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the
