
COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

County of Rockingham, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The grand jurors in and for the body of said county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its February term, 1930, upon their oaths do present that Bernard Lam, who was heretofore, on the 18th day of November, 1924, convicted of violating the Prohibition laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the Circuit Court of said Rockingham County, Virginia, and who then and there was sentenced to pay a fine of five hundred dollars and serve for a period of six months in jail, and who heretofore was also on July 18, 1927, convicted of violating the Prohibition laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the Circuit Court of Greene County, Virginia, and who then and there was sentenced to pay a fine of fifty dollars and serve for a period of six months in jail, did, on February 16, 1930, in the said county of Rockingham, unlawfully and feloniously receive, transport, and have in his possession ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of D. H. Dofflemyer and John Logan, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
