



This Indenture made the 1th day of September
In the yeare of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred forty ~~and~~ between George Branner
Overseer of the poor for the district of the County
of Rockingham of the one part Elizabeth Moore of
said County of the other part witnesseth that
the said George Branner Overseer of the poor as
aforesaid by virtue of an order of the Court of
the aforesaid County bearing date the 18th day of
August 1845 have put place and bound and by
their presents do put place and Bind Lucy a free
Girl of Couler of the age of Eleven years to learn
the house keeping with her the said Elizabeth
Moore and as an apprentice with her the said
Elizabeth Moore to dwell from the date these
presents until the said Lucy shall attain the
age of Eighteen years according to the act of the
General Assembly in that case made and
provided. by and during which time and
term the said Lucy shall the said Elizabeth
Moore her said mistress well and faithfully
serve in all such Lawful business as the said
Lucy shall be put unto by her said mistress
according to the power, wit and ability of her
the said Lucy and honestly and obediently in
all such things shall behave herself towards her
said mistress and honestly and orderly towards
the rest of the family of the said Elizabeth
Moore and the said Elizabeth Moore for her
part for herself Executors and Administrators doth
here by promise and covenant to and with the said
Overseer of the poor and every of them their and
every of their Executors and Administrators and their
and every of their successors for the time being and to

and with the said Lucey that the said Elizabeth
Moore shall instruct the said Lucey in the Craft
mystery and Occupation of a house Keeper which
she the said Elizabeth Moore now uses, after the
best manner that she can or may, teach instruct
and inform; cause to be taught instructed and
informed^{as} much as thereunto belongeth, or in
any wise appertaineth, and that the said
Elizabeth Moore shall also find and allow unto
the said apprentice sufficient meat drink apparel
washing, Lodging, and all other things needfull
or meet for an apprentice, during the terms
aforesaid, and will moreover pay to the said
mother of said Lucey the sume of two dollars
a yeare for seven yeares, and Eleven dollars to
said girl when she arrives to the age of Eighteen
yeares for the true performance & bind my own
special property, on witness whereof, the parties
have interchangeably set there hands and
seals to these presents the day and yeare
first above written
