That on May 13th, 1923, W.L. Dillard, Sheriff of

said County, did on the Valley Turnpike south of Harrisonburg, in
Rockingham County, Virginia, seize a Birch touring car, model
D36, engine number 1137; said car at the time of seizure

in said car at the time about one-half gallon of ardent spirits,
commonly known as moonshine liquor.
