

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 8th day of April

in the year of our Lord 1830 Between Jacob Comrad Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Samuel Gibbons

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid

~~having~~ ~~the~~ day of At August term in the year 1829

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind William Williams of the age

of Fourteen years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Samuel Gibbons

and as an Apprentice with him the said Samuel Gibbons to dwell from the date of these presents,

until the said William Williams shall arrive and come to the age of twenty one

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. by and during all which time and term the said

William Williams shall the said Samuel Gibbons his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Samuel Gibbons William Williams

shall be put unto by S^d Samuel Gibbons according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him

the said William Williams honestly and obediently in all things behave towards

said Samuel Gibbons and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said Samuel Gibbons And the said Samuel Gibbons

for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a House Joiner

which he the said Samuel Gibbons now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said Samuel Gibbons shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that

the said Samuel Gibbons shall teach or cause to be taught to the said William Williams

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said William

Williams the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year

above written.
