It is suggested that the exact language used in the recordetion order under sub-heads B, C. D. stc., down to Y, be used in recording each - that is just preceding the entry of the order, judgment, etc.

Rowever it will be necessary, as indicated above, to change slightly the language in sub-head 4, as set out in the order so as to make it serve its purpose in the connection in which it will be used in the Deed Book. See A above.
