other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the *twentieth* day of *December* in the year 1837 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Gordon Harrell* of the age of *sixteen* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *George W Sanford*

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said

And the said

George W Sanford for himself his Executors and

Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation

of *Boot and Shoe Making*

which he the said

George W Sanford

now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said

George W Sanford

shall also find

and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the the term aforesaid: And also that the said

George W Sanford

shall teach, or cause to be taught to the

Gordon Harrell

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three

and will moreover pay to the said

Gordon Harrell

the Sum of

Twenty

Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
