

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE

Cootes one of the Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Robt Cogley* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the ¹⁸³⁰ day of *June* in the year ~~1830~~ ¹⁸³⁰ has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Rebecca Howles* of the age of *Two years in Feb. 1830* to be an Apprentice with him the said *Robt Cogley* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Robt Cogley* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Rebecca Howles* shall arrive and come to the age of *18* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Rebecca Howles* shall the said *Robt Cogley* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Rebecca Howles* shall be put unto by ~~his~~ ^{her} said *Master* according to the Power Wit and Ability of the said *Rebecca Howles* and the said *Rebecca* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Robt Cogley* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Robt Cogley* And the said *Robt Cogley* for himself ~~his~~ ^{her} Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *Common Weaving* which he the said *Robt Cogley* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Robt Cogley* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Robt Cogley* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *Rebecca* Reading, Writing, ~~and Common Arithmetic~~ ^{including the} ~~Rule of Three~~, and will moreover pay to the said *Rebecca Howles* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
