

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE Tenth day of March in the year of our Lord 18 28 Between Reuben Moore Overseer of the Poor of the So. East District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Jacob Huff of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the fourth day of January in the year one thousand Eighteen hundred & twenty eight has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind William Mahoney of the age of seven years & 5 months, to be an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Huff and as an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Huff to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Apprentice shall arrive and come to the age of twenty one years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Apprentice shall the said Jacob Huff his said Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said William Mahoney shall be put unto by Jacob Huff according to the Power, Wit and Ability of William Mahoney the said William Mahoney shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards Jacob Huff his said Master and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of the said Jacob Huff And the said Jacob Huff for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Joiner which he the said Jacob Huff now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Jacob Huff shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said Jacob Huff shall teach or cause to be taught to the said William Mahoney Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said William Mahoney the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
