belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said Felix Shettman shall also find. and allow unto the said apprentie sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging and all other things needful, or meet for an appe = rentice during the term aforesaid, and also that the said Felix Shellman, shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Stobert Travis, reading, writing and common arithmetic including the rule of three, and will moreover pay to The said Statest Traves, the sum of Twelve bollans, at the expination of his aforesaid terms, In witness whereof the parties to these presents have interchangeably set their hands and seals the day and year first above written, Jelin Shettman Soals
