This Indenture Made This fifteenth Day of February in the year of our lord one thousand toight thundred & fortyfive between Abraham Byrd overseer of the Poor of the first district of the joy Bookingham, of the one paint I birus Shitzer of said loventy of the other part, winefeeth, that the Said Abraham Byrd, Oversees of the pool as aforesaid, by virtue of an order of the Court of the aforesaid County Baring date December 16. 1845 have put placed and bound, and by these Prescents do put, pluce and bind Joseph Mooney son of Belog Morney of the age of twelve years to be an Appointice with him the Said Ceras Spitzed, and as an apprentice with him the said Cirus Spilzed to dwell, from the date of these presents until The said Joseph Mooney Shall allain the age of twentyone years, according to the act of the general sasfemlely in thut ease mude and provided, By and during all which time & term the Said Joseph Mooney, Shall the said Cirus Spelyed his Master, well and Faithfully serve, in all Such lawfull Buisness as the Suid Joseph Mooney Shall be put unto By his Said Master, according to the power wit and ability of him the Said Joseph Moonly and honestly and obediently in all things Shall behave timself towards his said mosts and honestly & orderly lowards the rest of the family of the Suid Cerus Spilzer, and the suid Cirus Spelzer for his past for himself, his Executors and administrators doth hereby fromis and Covenant to and with the said over seet of the pood and Every of them their Executors of administrators and their and evory of their Successors for the time being and to and with The said Joseph Mooney that he the said Corus Spilze I shale Instruct the said Joseph Mooney in the not and buisness of Farming and agriculture which he the said bisis spitzes is now engugedin, in the best Manner That he can of may Teach and instruct as much as thereunts belongeth, and Mul the said Cirus Spilzed Shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice Sufficient ment drink appeared washing Lodging and all other things needfull or meet for an apprenting

During the term aforesaid and also that the sew birus Spilzer Shall Teach or eause to be laught to the said Joseph Mooney reading writing and Common withmetics including The rate of three and will moreoved pay the said Joseph Mooney the sum of twenty dollars at the Expiration of the aforesuid term in witness whereof.
