

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE

day of *Novemb<sup>r</sup>* in the year of our Lord 1830 Between *Samuel Coote*

one of the Overseer of the Poor of the *Sec<sup>ond</sup>* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *David Denton*

the other part witnesseth, that the said Overeer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the *6<sup>th</sup>* day of *March*.

in the year 1826 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* of the age of *Eighth* + years

*the 8<sup>th</sup> day of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1826* to be an Apprentice with him the said *David Denton* and as an Apprentice with him the said *David Denton* to dwell from the

~~date of these presents~~, until the said *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General

Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* shall the said *David Denton*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said ~~*Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown*~~ shall be put unto by his said *Master*

according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* and the said *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* honestly and obediently in all things be-

have towards the said *David Denton* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *David Denton* And the

said *David Denton* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the

Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *a farm* which

he the said *David Denton* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and

informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *David Denton* shall also find and allow unto the said

Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

*David Denton* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the *S<sup>r</sup> Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the

Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Jam<sup>s</sup> Brown* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
