This Indenture Witnessell that I James Quinn One of the Everseers of the poor for the County of Rocking how I state of Virginia doth by these presents ful and Bright Sin'il being by an order of bourt he being fourteen years of lage that fiftuenth day of June 1794 and to serve him in the said bounty and state of Virginia untill he a Rives to the age of twenty one years during which time the said apprintice his spired Master shall fall fully serve his secrets keep his Lawfull Commands every where Dbey he shall do no damage to his said master nor witfully Suffer it to be done by Others he shall Meither buy norsell formication he shall not Commit Matinon he shall not Contract at Cards dice or anyother unlawfull Game he shall not play with his Masters goods or the goods of others whereby his vaid Master may Receive dammage he shall Neether haund Taverns male houses or play house But in all things behave himself as a good and faithfull Sovant or apprintice bught to do In Cosideration where of the said master whall provide Suffreent Meatwark Ing Lodging and appeal fiting for such an apprintice weing the Said term to Learn him to Read and White & eigher through the Bule of three also to Learn him the art nd mistery of a tormer in the best morner of our tourty and al the experation of waid time pay or lause to be paid hree pounds ten Shillings to the said apprentice also to give him a good New suit of Cloathing where of Each party do bind themselves to the Bather Interchangeby By there presents seals withourseals and Dated this 25 day of November 1794 James Quin, O, Poludy Tofoings Caniel Seal In presence of Somey Miller Grafas
