

This Indenture Made the Twentieth Day of July in the Year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six  
Between John Rush one of the Overseers for the County of  
Buckingham Parish of the one Part and William Gul Blacksmith  
of the Parish aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth That when  
as a Court held for Buckingham County July the Twentieth<sup>th</sup> it was  
ordered that the Overseers of the Poor should bind out a Child  
named Charles Ineslor This Indenture therefore witnesseth that  
in Compliance of the above order I the said John Rush one of the  
Overseers as aforesaid Do hereby bind out the said Charles Ineslor  
to the said William Gul to serve him from the Date here of till he  
be of the age of Twenty one Years During which Time the said  
Charles Ineslor shall faithfully honestly and truly serve his  
Master all his Lawfull Commands gladly obey he shall not let nor  
suffer any damage to be done to his said Masters Goats without  
giving him Notice nor shall he at any time absent him self from  
his said Masters Service without  
Leave But always as true and honest Servant ought to Do serve his  
said Master Diligently honestly and truly During the said Term  
In Consideration of which Service the said William Gul doth Covenant  
Grant and agree to and with the said Overseer In Behalf of the said  
Charles Ineslor to provide goot and whole some Mead drin washing  
and doying with linnen and woollen and woollen clothes fitting for  
an apprentice and to teach him to cause him to be taught to bead write  
and Cypher as fare as the rule thre and to teach him the art and  
mystery of a Black Smith as fare as he knows and at the Expiration  
of the said Term to give him the usual allowance or Goating to Law
