in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
Seven Between John Boyde of Rockingham County
and State of Virginia of the one part and James Craige
of said County and State of the other part Witnesseth
that the said John Boyde by these presents doth put and
Bind his Daughter Peggy Boyde aged sixteen years
against the fourth Day of December Next as an
apprentice untill she arive to the age of eighteen years
and that she shall duly and faithfully serve the
said James Craige as a good and faithfull apprentice
ought to do during the said term and not to absent
her selfe day nor night without her said masters leave
in consideration of which service the said Craige
doth Covenant and agree to and with the said John
Boyde to find the said Peggy Boyde in good wholesome
Decent Cloathing meat Drink washing and lodging
during the said term and to give her three months Regular
Schooling and a good feather bed and furniture
with a Decent Suit of cloaths at the expiration of
the said term and to teach or cause her to be taught to knit
sew and spin to the true performance of each and
every of the above Covenants and agreements the parties
Bind them selves to each other In witness whereof we
